New York City Residential Sales Report

1st Qtr. 09



Executive Summary

Homes (includes all condominium, cooperative units and 1-3 family dwellings)

- The average sales price of a home in New York City during the first quarter of 2009 was \$660,000, a 23% drop compared to the average price during the first quarter of 2008. The individual borough's average home price declines though were not as steep as the city wide number.
- The average price in Brooklyn was down 10% to \$521,000. In Queens the average price dropped 8% year on year to \$422,000. The year on year change on the average price of a home in the Bronx was down 8% to \$365,000. The average price in Staten Island fell 6% year on year to \$401,000.
- The average sales price of a home in Manhattan during the first quarter of 2009 was \$1,424,000, an 11% drop compared to the average price during the first quarter of 2008.
- The large drop in the city wide homes number is largely the result of the decline in the number of sales of Manhattan condominiums and their average sales price.

Apartments (includes all condominium and cooperative units)

- The average sales price of an apartment in New York City during the first quarter of 2009 was \$805,000, a 19% drop year on year. The average price in Manhattan in the first quarter of 2009 was \$1,382,000 a drop of 11% from the first quarter of last year. The Bronx average price of \$239,000 is slightly up compared to last year. Brooklyn's average price of an apartment in the first quarter of 2009 was \$399,000, a fall of 18% from the previous year's first quarter. The average sales price of an apartment in Queens in the first quarter was down 1% from last year to \$288,000.

Condominiums

- The average sales price of condominiums in New York City in the first quarter of this year fell 10% to \$1,156,000. Manhattan experienced a 5% drop in the average price to \$1,741,000 and its sales volume fell 63%, further than any other borough. The average price of \$516,000 in Brooklyn was a fall of 12% year on year; this was the largest percentage drop in all of the boroughs. The average price in Queens climbed 21% to \$486,000 and the average price in the Bronx rose 4% to \$269,000. These increases were the result of a concentration of closings in new developments such as 50-09 2nd St and 10-40 46th Road in Queens as well as 53 Beacon Lane in the Bronx.

Cooperatives

- The average sales price of cooperative units in New York City fell by 25% to \$518,000 this quarter compared to the first quarter last year, the result of fewer sales of high end units. The average sales price in Manhattan fell 19% year on year to \$961,000. The average sales price in Brooklyn was down 13% year on year to \$300,000. In Queens, a coops unit's average sales price fell 10% to \$222,000 during the first quarter of 2009. The average price of a coop in the Bronx decreased this quarter compared to last year's first quarter by 2% to \$215,000.

One - Three Family Dwelling

- The average sales price of a New York City 1-3 family dwelling in the first quarter of 2009 fell by 18% year on year to \$526,000. Queens experienced a decline in average sales price of a 1-3 family dwelling of 15% year on year to \$491,000. The average price of a 1-3 family dwelling in Brooklyn was \$610,000, a 10 percent drop. In the Bronx, the average price dropped 11% to \$436,000. The average sales price in Staten Island was \$420,000 which was a 7% drop compared to last year.

Executive Summary

Manhattan Neighborhoods

- The average condominium sales price in TriBeCa in the first quarter of 2009 was \$3,578,000, an increase of 57% over the first quarter of 2008. Furthermore, there were only 5 fewer sales this quarter than there were in the first quarter of 2008. Most of this gain is attributed to closings at 101 Warren Street.
- The average sales price of condominiums on the Upper East Side increased 25% to \$2,377,000 this quarter when compared to the first quarter of 2008. This average sales price was primarily the result of closings at 40 and 200 East 66th Street.
- The average sales price of a coop unit on the Upper East Side was \$1,424,000 which is a drop of 27% compared to the first quarter of last year, primarily the result of a decline in the higher end of this market.
- The average price of a coop on the Upper West Side also fell this quarter compared to the first quarter of last year. The average of price of a coop unit there fell 12% to \$999,000.

Brooklyn Neighborhoods

- The average sales price of a condominium unit in Greenpoint in the first quarter of 2009 was \$543,000, an increase of 7% over the first quarter of last year. Given the back drop of falling sales in the borough, Greenpoint maintained relatively good volume; there were 17 sales recorded in this quarter compared to 24 this quarter last year.
- The average sales price of a condominium unit in Park Slope rose 6% this quarter to \$698,000 when compared to last year. Recorded sales in the neighborhood did dip though from 57 to 31 this quarter compared to the first quarter of 2008.
